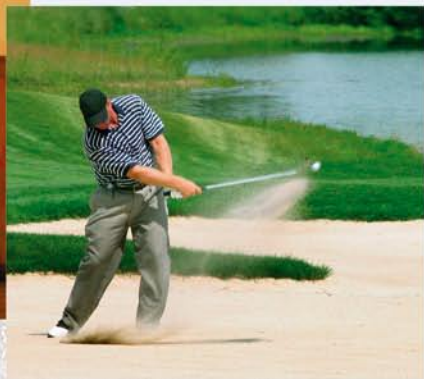

THE ACCOMMODATION

Clearwater is a luxurious development of eight stylish semi-detached houses ideally located in the heart of Glenbeigh Village on the Ring of Kerry. First opened in Summer 2005, each of these houses has three bedrooms - one master double bedroom with ensuite bathroom, one twin bedroom (also ensuite) and a single bedroom with a separate bathroom. Some houses also feature a double sofa bed to sleep two more people. There is a guest toilet downstairs.



Clearwater Holiday Homes are heated with oil-fired central heating and have plenty of storage space.



One of the houses has been especially adapted for wheelchair users with a bedroom and bathroom downstairs. This particular house has four bedrooms.



The living room is spacious and features a cosy suite of furniture, electric fireplace, TV and stereo. The kitchen has all modern conveniences including electric oven, microwave, washer/dryer and dishwasher. Patio doors lead from the dining area out to the private back garden and patio with garden furniture. The houses also have a small front garden planted with flowerbeds and there is a larger green area in front of the houses for children to play. There is private off-street parking for each house.

Rossbeigh Beach

Glenbeigh is probably best known for its golden blue flag unspoilt Rossbeigh beach which lies on the outskirts of the village.
